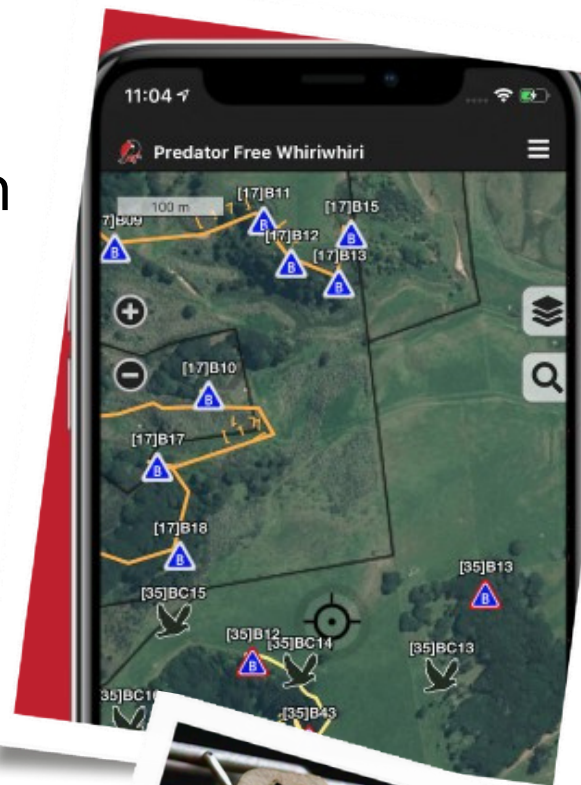

Add traps using Trap.NZ app	Add traps using computer
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click 'install' at bottom left of screen • Use the target cursor to select the location of your trap • Click on the green tick at bottom left of screen • Select 'trap' • Give your trap a name (Code) e.g. Trap 1 • Select the trap type e.g. DOC 200 • Click & hold down 'save' 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click 'traps' • Click 'Add a new trap' • Give your trap a name (Code) e.g. Trap 1 • Select the trap type e.g. DOC 200 • Click 'save'

Note: We find using the Trap.NZ app on your mobile device is the easiest way to manage your traps.

If you already have traps set up on Trap.NZ you can add them to one of our predator control zones:

- Request to join one of the Predator Control Zones
- Click 'traps'
- Select 'manage traps'
- Under 'operations' select 'move traps to another project' + click execute
- Choose the desired Predator Control Zone

Adding your trap catch: The easiest way to record what you catch is by using the Trap.NZ app on your phone

Using Trap.NZ app	Using computer
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select your trap • Select the species caught e.g. Rat, , or 'none' if nothing caught. • Press and hold 'save' 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select 'traps' • Select 'Add catches' • Select the species caught e.g. Rat • Click 'Apply' <p>Or if you have multiple traps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select 'traps' • Select 'Add catches' • Choose a trap type and click 'Apply' • Then add any catch to each trap.
